Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President Stephen McMinn.

Review of Prior Meeting Minutes- A review of the minutes was held and a motion to approve the minutes was made by Susan Jacoby and seconded by Liz Fons. The motion carried. A clarification was made that the amount approved in the minutes was for the high school and the same amount for the middle school.

Gina asked how we were doing with Senior gifts for the concert and Jeff Randall said we will do the same as we did last year. The Spring Concert for GHS will be 5/9 and for GMS it will be 5/7. Drum Major try-outs are tom. And percussion try-outs will follow.

Jazz Band Dance- Aly Grady said we will be able to set everything up on the Friday night before the dance as well as after school. She will have a volunteer sign up for tickets, the dessert table and the band room. Aly has posters to be distributed around town and at the retirement communities. She also has a submission for the clarion. Steve McMinn will have a list of those who will be receiving free Jazz Band tickets at the ticket counter. Steve will also get a 50/50 license from the county.

Executive Committee- Larry made a motion that was seconded by Steve that elections will be at the May meeting and nominations will be accepted tonight and at the May meeting. The motion carried.

Uniforms- Brenda Stephens stated that the way we did uniforms in Disney worked out well. It was easier since we did not have to take the plumes and hats. Disney was able to provide items that were accidently forgotten. We will need to order gloves after the May meeting and see how many plumes will be needed. The uniforms will need to be cleaned as well.

Membership- Steve stated that membership is working on the list for the Jazz Band Dance as well as for Senior night. Larry will follow up with Mrs. Try about speaking at the Middle School Concert about joining band boosters.

Fundraising- The propane fundraiser is currently underway. Barb will give flyers about the propane fundraiser to Jade to take to the middle school.

Old Business- Jeff Randall stated he spoke to Karen Gupta because she thought she had paid twice for band. Jeff did find out that we do owe her a \$25.00 reimbursement. April asked if anyone had any pictures from Disney they wanted to try and get in the school ebullitin. The pictures need to go to Betsy Schroder by 4.25. April had previously emailed the board. Gina said she would see if a senior student could do this. Gina was also going to check with Bob Rogers about the app.

New Business- Steve opened the floor for band booster officer nominations. April Cook was nominated for President by Susan Jacoby. April Cook nominated Heather Lowary for Secretary. Larry Fons nominated Jeff Randall for Vice President. Andrea Perry was also nominated by Larry Fons for Treasure. Justin Perry will be our new webmaster. The board gave Heather Lowary the go ahead to get ready to have Spirit Wear orders ready for band camp. A summer fundraiser was discussed, and Barb suggested Chipotle.
